Who:

Children who reside in Frederick County, are suspected of having an educational disability, and are not currently enrolled in a public school.

If services are warranted, they are generally delivered in neighborhood elementary schools. Referrals, initial meetings, and evaluations are usually completed at the Child Find Office.
