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Scope of Work

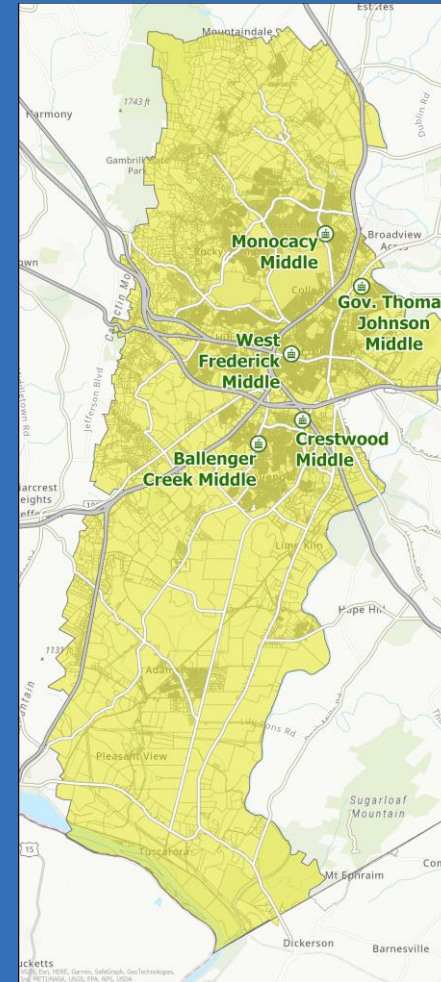
- The purpose of this redistricting study is to adjust attendance boundaries between the middle schools in the Crestwood area to balance enrollments.
- Elementary and high school boundaries will be adjusted as necessary to preserve feeder patterns.
- This redistricting is in conjunction with an addition to Crestwood Middle.

Study Area

- Middle schools: Ballenger Creek, Crestwood, Gov. Thomas Johnson (west of the Monocacy River), Monocacy, and West Frederick
- Elementary schools: Ballenger Creek, Butterfly Ridge, Carroll Manor, Hillcrest, Lewistown (Monocacy Middle School feeder), Lincoln, Monocacy, North Frederick, Orchard Grove, Parkway, Spring Ridge (west of the Monocacy River), Tuscarora, Waverley, Whittier, and Yellow Springs.
- High schools: Frederick, Governor Thomas Johnson (west of the Monocacy River), and Tuscarora.

- Implement new attendance boundaries:----- August 2024
