ABOUT SUCCESS

SUCCESS is a secondary transition/vocational education program designed for students 18-21 years of age with disabilities.

Students enrolled:

- Completed at least 4 years in a comprehensive high school
- Work to earn a Maryland certificate of completion
- Are motivated, energetic and enthusiastic young adults interested in gaining work experience and discovering a career that suits them best
- Work in a community-based setting to learn skills for independent living and gain experience in the world of work



THE WORK DAY

- 2 or 4 days a week either
 - Mornings- 8:30-11:00
 - Afternoons- 11:15-1:15
- Students work as volunteers with an on-site job coach
- Typical work can include but is not limited to:
 - Cleaning, dusting, filing, laundry, folding, custodial, organizing, stocking, outdoor landscaping, kitchen prep, childcare assistant and more!
